Boat Yard Cleanliness

Customers/Contractors must ensure the work area around the vessel is always kept in a clean and tidy manner. A charge of €100 will be levied if a vessel launches without tidying the area to cover the costs of cleaning and waste disposal.

Conditions

1. Winter storage subject to availability
2. Repairs of a major nature to be executed by Malahide Marina Village staff or by approved contractors
3. Supplies of electricity and water are subject to availability. Electricity is charged at the rate shown on the current tariff. Malahide Marina Village reserve the right to meter electricity supplied to any vessel in the Marina or Boat Yard
4. Invoices must be paid in full prior to launching
5. All vessels stored ashore remain subject to the Marina Terms and Conditions. Copy available on the website or at reception
6. All contractors must submit insurance and a health and safety statement to the office prior to commencing work
7. **Staying onboard the vessel whilst in the yard is not permitted at any time.**
